### Annual Highlights:

- (1) The department was again able to maintain a Bike Patrol Program using grant monies, as well as other OHS enforcement grants.
- (2) The department has 46% more traffic arrests in 2009, nearly doubling the 2008 figures. While criminal incidents rose by 16%, arrests increased by 22%. Traffic collisions also incurred a 22% increase over 2008 stats.
- (3) The Dagsboro Police Department is third in the state for traffic arrests per capita. This is of the 57 agencies authorized to issue citations within the State.
- (4) The department currently has 7 criminal arrest warrants on file generated from crimes that occurred this year. There are no other warrants in the department unexecuted. At the time of this report officers are actively investigating 2 serious incidents and have developed suspects with hopes that arrests will follow shortly.
